A free health app that puts each patient's key medical information in their pocket — for South Africa & Namibia

What it is

A virtual health card on the patient's own phone: allergies, chronic conditions (ICD-10 coded), current medications with doses, blood type, previous operations, medical aid scheme & plan (full SA register + Namibian NAMAf funds), and emergency contacts — with a QR code any provider can scan for the essentials. **Privacy by design:** all data is stored only on the patient's phone. Nothing is uploaded to any server.

★ Built-in Pre-Operative Health Questionnaire — for surgeons & anaesthetists

12 structured sections: procedure · allergies (drug, latex, food) · all medications incl. anticoagulants, insulin & steroids · medical & anaesthetic history (incl. family history of malignant hyperthermia) · cardiac/respiratory screen with STOP-BANG · liver & kidney function · musculoskeletal · airway assessment · fasting status · social history · signed declaration. Auto-fills from the saved profile; the patient sends it to the surgeon and anaesthetist by WhatsApp or email — or prints it as a PDF.

- ✓ Hospital Admission Helper — admission-form details for Netcare, Mediclinic, Life & state hospitals **NEW**
- ✓ Medical-aid pre-authorisation number & checklist
- ✓ New Patient Form — structured first-visit history **NEW**
- ✓ Menstrual cycle tracker & Bump-to-Baby pregnancy diary **NEW**
- ✓ Blood pressure & blood sugar logs (traffic-light feedback)
- ✓ Vaccination record · lab results & radiology (with photos)
- ✓ Medication barcode scanner, prescription photo & daily tracker
- ✓ PMB checker & coverage guide (SA schemes + Namibian NAMAf)
- ✓ Family profiles — children AND elderly parents
- ✓ Find Care · Emergency SOS · Share Details · AI assistant (60+ topics)
- ✓ Backup & Restore · blood donation, travel insurance, pet health, funeral services

Why it helps us as clinicians: accurate medication lists and allergy histories at the bedside · structured pre-op information before theatre · scannable emergency data for unconscious or confused patients · fewer “I can't remember my pills, doctor” consultations. Every user can pass the app on with the built-in “Share this app” button — it shares only the link, never personal data.

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
